The sand lizard can grow to between 20 and 24 CM in length!



When a predator poses a danger, the sand lizard can shed a part of its tail. The aim is to divert the attention of the robber to the shed twitching piece of tail, so you can flee quickly to safety. In time a shorter, new tail regrows. However, the sand lizard can no longer grow to a body length of 24 cm!



10 climbing poles are waiting here to be conquered by you. Your job is to climb from the first pole to the last as quickly as possible and without touching the ground.

As we humans do not have claws to allow us to flit quickly through the obstacle course like a sand lizard, there are handles which you can hold on to as you move along.

It becomes particularly difficult when two challengers from the opposite ends of the course try to climb past each other, hoping to arrive first at the other side.
