The fur on the tips of the ears of the  
**SQUIRRELS** – the “ear tufts” – look  
like the head of a brush and for this  
reason are also known as “Ohrpinsel”  
– “ear brushes” – in German.

Thanks to their strong back legs, squirrels can jump up to **5 METRES** horizontally!



“ Squirrels are swift climbers and good jumpers. Although they cannot fly, it almost looks like they can, when they glide for metres through the air high up in the trees. Here their bushy tails serve as rudders and help them keep their balance. Squirrels’ feet are padded with thick balls which absorb the impact after a long jump.
