






Thanks to their strong back legs, squirrels can jump up to \ METRES horizontally!



Squirrels are swift climbers and good jumpers. Although they cannot fly, it almost looks like they can, when they glide for metres through the air high up in the trees. Here their bushy tails serve as rudders and help them keep their balance. Squirrels' feet are padded with thick balls which absorb the impact after a long jump.







Help the squirrels to pile up food for the winter.
